International Art Show in October, featuring art from countries including Nicaragua, Nepal and Kenya, and its year-round international jewelry selection draw holiday shoppers.

And with the help of "corporate buyers" (e.g., hospitals or office buildings that need to soften their offices with art) and the gallery's new frame shop, fall and early winter can be prosperous, said Algueseva.

"But February and March

are not big money-makers," he added. "You can pay the bills, but you don't make big profits. Those are the toughest months."
