made antique furniture known as "primitives," have fairly steady appreciation rates because of their inherent value. However, supply and demand has a more noticeable effect on toys — especially newer ones — and it is hard to predict their future value.

Edmondson put it simply: "Some become more valuable; some just don't."

Beanie Babies are a perfect example of how the unstable collectible toy mar-

ket can change overnight, said Kroes.

Stuffed toys, once bought by the thousands and hoarded as if they were worth their weight in gold, are a rather dead item these days, according to Kroes, who said that Downtown Antiques and Collectibles is forced to sell them below cost.

"And we're lucky to be selling them at all," she added.

But few toy aficionados collect merely for the sake of investment.

"It's more of a hobby.

You've really got to love antique-ing — love the hunt," said Kroes.

Sondag agreed that when it

comes to collectibles, the journey is as much fun as the destination.

"People like to be able to see, smell and touch them — to move the wheels and the arms."

For many collectors, the "challenge and the chase" are as much a part of the hobby as the owning of the items.

"When you find that thing you've been looking for — when you see it and it just clicks, it's really cool," she said.

In fact, she added, it's so cool that it can be an addiction for some people. "Once you start, it's hard to stop."
