He appeared tired and drawn. The group kept calling to me to come over and see "Dad." Needless to say, "Tacky" was more than happy to oblige and sat on his lap and flirted outrageously. The gentleman's eyes lit up and he chuckled and blushed the whole time. Six weeks later, I received a note from a family in the Manistee area. They wrote to thank me for spending time with their father at the parade. He had been terminally ill and died six weeks later, but for all of those weeks, kept laughing and talking about that "Tacky" who recognized a "quality" male when she saw one. It was one of the most touching and humbling experiences that reinforced for me that we never know how our acts will effect someone and the importance of spreading fun and love whenever we can.
