

A chaplain and his lifetime of giving hope

Founded in 1961, Forgotten Man Ministries started with a single committed chaplain at Kent County Jail. Today there are 33 chaplains serving in jails throughout Michigan, with a home office located in Grand Rapids.

Chaplain Bob Hall has been working with jail inmates even longer — over 50 years. Aside from Grand Traverse County Jail, in recent years Hall has added Leland and Benzie County jails to his schedule, with assistance from his wife, Jaimee.

The Forgotten Man Ministries works with inmates in a number of ways. They may receive one-on-one counseling sessions, worship services, Bible study classes, Bible Correspondence School, anger management and drug/alcohol education classes, Christian literature and videos.

FMM chaplains do not work alone. Local churches and volunteers help and support them in their ministry.

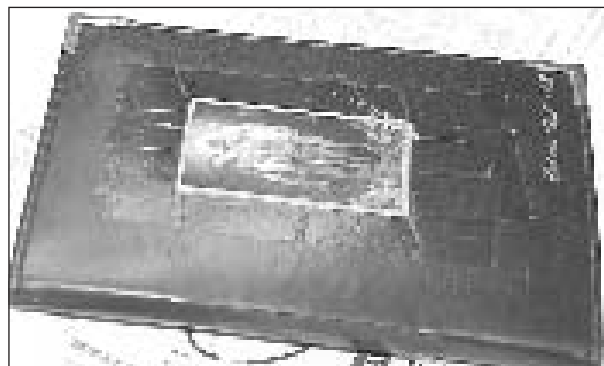
Throughout the year, chaplains need help from local church groups to organize special or ongoing projects. Volunteers can help run the program and also talk with inmates.

Forgotten Man Ministries receives no state or federal funding and rely solely on gifts from involved churches, citizens and businesses.
