# Plumstead runs down history

Benzie back eyes career rushing list

BENZONIA — It started out innocently enough.

During his freshman football season in 2000, Benzie Central's John Plumstead was thrown into the offensive backfield.

The staff, head coach Hal Holman recalls, planned on limiting the freshman's carries to "four or five" because "we didn't want to get him killed."

Plumstead, in his first real duties rushing the ball, racked said. "I wasn't looking at all up 161 yards and three touchdowns against Boyne City.

Now, as he enters his senior season, Plumstead is leader of the pack. With 5,011 yards he can climb up the top 10 alltime rushers in the state of Michigan.

"As a freshman, I just wanted to get out on the field and prove myself," Plumstead four years. But I'm proud of it, that's for sure."

"He's at top speed in three steps," TC St. Francis coach Josh Sellers said. "He's patient... and patient... then he finds an opening and he's gone, and nobody's going to catch him."

As a freshman, Plumstead ended up rushing for 1,103 yards. He followed that up with 1,728 as a sophomore and took it another step further with 2,180 as Benzie reached the state semifinals in 2002.

If Plumstead runs for the same total as last season, he'll be just 21 yards behind Ravenna's Benny Clark Jr. for second-place all-time.

"For sure I'd love to see my

name up there if I can rush for another 2,000 yards," Plumstead said. "Hopefully I

can do that and a little more. Hopefully we can add one more game so we can play all 14 of them."

"He's knocking on the door (of the all-time list)," Holman said. "I don't want to jinx myself — or him."

Even more remarkable is how Plumstead got to carry the ball in the first place. On the varsity to play defensive back, Plumstead got to carry the ball when a senior back quit the team after the second game.

"This is the next kid we've got is Plumstead," Holman said. "So we put him in there and that's how it all happened. It's the best coaching move I've ever made."
