"There are some new construction techniques that have really improved RVs," said Belanger. "Some manufacturers are trending toward an ultra-light design with a fiberglass laminated exterior and an aluminum framework. They're very lightweight, so people can pull them with less vehicle horsepower. Plus, they're insulated on six sides with a sealed underbelly to protect tanks and plumbing, and that makes them winter friendly."

Though the economy may be in a state of flux, but the RV industry is thriving.

"The industry had a record year last year and this year has started off the same," said Dellinger. "People just don't want to fly, and they're getting more and more into camping as a family unit. Plus, we're seeing trends toward more local vacations and that's good for Michigan.'

Denton notes that there are 9.3 million RVs on the roads nationwide and 10 percent of Michigan pleasure travelers camp. With many retailers up as much as 42 percent in RV sales, campgrounds nationwide may expect to see a leap in visitors this year.
