Applying paint to railings, fence posts, trim and flashing can be tedious because of preparation. Hammerite RustCap eliminates prep work because it doesn't need a primer; the paint is applied directly to rusted iron and steel. The paint dries to a rust-encapsulating coating that contains glass flakes. This glass interlocks with special resins to form a protective layer that moisture can't penetrate. No moisture, no rust.

There are four readymade motifs to consider: a nursery (Pooh Collection), a bathroom (Mickey Collection) and two children's rooms (Princess and Pooh).

Of course, Skil has a vested interest in all that construction, which is why the company is sponsoring National Build Your Own Deck Week (May 3-10) and launching a nationwide search for the five best do-ityourself decks (see www.skil.com for details).

According to a survey by Remodeling magazine, an average deck costs \$5,854 and generally recoups 75 percent of its value when the house is sold, the biggest bang for your buck of any outdoor improvement other than painting.

Average number of years before a deck is replaced or remodeled: 11 years.
