"We're about providing companionship for singles." said Patricia Hample, chairperson of the Michigan chapter of Loners on Wheels (L.O.W.)

Members of L.O.W. gather Canada and Mexico. for monthly camp-outs and rallies where they do crafts, dance, play games, travel and "just have a good time," Hample said.

Edith Lane started Loners on Wheels in 1969 in Death Valley, California. She met other singles on the RV circuit with similar interests, but found that they did not always fit into the couples scene. The club now has chapters in 40 states,

Although L.O.W. is technically open to people of all ages, Hample said that most members are retirees.

"They have the necessary time, money and flexibilitv." she said.

Many L.O.W. members have been married in the past but are currently single again, either through divorce or the death of their partners. Some simply never married.

Hample said that L.O.W. is "matchmaker" environment especially important for the latter group because other members act as a surrogate family.

L.O.W. also does its best to keep its organization from becoming a dating service, or as Hample said, "a pick-up club."

Although some people do find partners through their involvement, including Hample herself (she met her fiancee through L.O.W.), a

is discouraged by certain club rules. For example, during official L.O.W. events, no person can share a "rig" with a person of the opposite sex.

The reason for these policies, Hample said, is not to control what people do but to make sure that the true purpose of L.O.W. is made clear: "We are a support system."
