Designed by William H. Diddel,
The Classic became the founding
course of the Gaylord Golf
Mecca. The signature hole, no.

and former PGA Tour player and NBC golf commentator Gary Koch. It features rolling elevation changes through forested valleys with spectacular views that stretch for 30 miles. The tee on the third hole overlooks the Sturgeon River Valley.

Rick Smith Tradition This course is designed for walking and is built to National Audubon Society specifications. One of the best courses in northern Michigan. (800) 444-6711.

Robert Trent Jones
Masterpiece This challenging
course at Sylvan Resort was
designed by Robert Trent Jones.
It's very hilly and wooded, with
many elevated tees and greens.
Water comes into play on four
