#### Saab

The 2003 Saab 9-3 sport sedan, just introduced last fall, adds two high-output turbo models in 2003.

Both new models, the 2003 9-3 Arc and 9-3 Vector, have a 210-horsepower, 2-liter, turbocharged four-cylinder, up from 175 horses in the base 9-3 Linear model that debuted last year.

And where the base Linear comes with a five-speed manual, the uplevel Arc and Vector models have a sixspeed manual. A five-speed automatic also is available for all three.

#### Saturn

The coupe version of Saturn's new Ion small car is a quad coup, with dual rearaccess doors which are an industry first.

The 2003 Ion coupe combines the sleek styling of a two-door model with two abbreviated and unobtrusive rear doors for easy back-seat access.

A 140-horsepower, Ecotec 2.2-liter four-cylinder engine is standard in all Ions. The standard transmission is a five-speed manual. But a VTi variable transmission available on the quad coupe is the first application of a continuously variable transmission on a high-volume compact car in North America.

#### Scion

The auto industry's newest brand begins selling cars in June in California before heading for a nationwide launch in summer, 2004. Scion is a new Toyota brand

aimed at young buyers. The first models to be sold are xA and xB.

The xA is a subcompact fivedoor hatchback with sculpted wheel arches. It's powered by a 108-horsepower, 1.5-liter four-cylinder. Buyers can select either a standard fivespeed manual transmission or an available four-speed automatic.

The xB looks like a blockish miniwagon and is modeled after a Toyota model called the Black Box in Japan. There's a flat floor and it seats five inside.

The xB has the same engine and transmission offerings as the xA. AP Photo/Subaru

The turbocharged Impreza WRX from Subaru, previously sold only overseas, comes to the United States this year in limited numbers.

### Subaru

Subaru is bringing a 300horsepower Impreza WRX STi model to the U.S. this summer.

The most powerful version of the turbocharged Impreza WRX, the rally racinginspired STi has, until this year, been sold only in Japan and Europe.

The STi engine is a 2.5-liter, turbocharged and intercooled, double overhead cam, four-cylinder boxer unit capable of generating 300 footpounds of torque at 4,000 rpm. The tachometer goes to 9,000 rpm in the STi, and there's only one transmission — a close-ratio, six-speed manual. Numbers will be limited to

4,000 or 5,000 annually.

The all-wheel-drive STi will be a 2004 model, incorporating new front styling that's debuting in showrooms right about now on regular 2004 Subaru Impreza models.
