# Storing flammables

According to the national fire incident reporting system, a majority of residential fires and fire-related injuries results from improperly stored flammables such as gasoline. Frequently, its the vapors and not the liquid that lead to a disastrous fire or explosion. Children are especially vulnerable due to their lack of understanding of the hazards of flammables. Gasoline, for example, is a motor fuel - not a cleanproduct. Flammables should not be stored near an ignition source such as a water heater, stove or furnace. Store flammables on a high shelf out of the reach of little ones and in a detached garage or shed, if possible. Use only ulapproved containers for gasoline storage. And, never store gasoline in a plastic water jug

Now there's an oven that keeps the food cool until it's time to bake. Whirlpool Home Appliances' Polara range has an oven cavity that doubles as a refrigerator. A timer controls the functions, so users can prepare meals up to a day in advance and have them kept fresh throughout the day and ready to eat at a designated time. The oven even takes care of things if you're not home in time. It automatically kicks into a warming period for up to an hour after the baking time ends, then back to refrigeration mode for up to 24 hours. No customized installation is required, the company said. Suggested retail prices for the 30-inch range are \$1,799 for white, black and biscuit-colored units and \$1,899 for stainless steel. It is first being sold by Sears but should be available at other appliance retailers soon.
