

Hole-In-One Golf contest could bring winner a new home

Golfers should hone their skills in preparation for the National Cherry Festival's week-long Hole-In-One Golf Contest sponsored by Garland and Passageways/Carlson Wagonlit Travel in cooperation with Sunny 101.9. The eight-day event takes place July 3-10 at Traverse City's Bay Meadows Golf Course and Lee Houtteman Learning Center, just two miles from Traverse City on Barney Road.

Festival-goers will take their best shots at a hole-in-one on a specially designed and built golf hole, playing 79 yards through the final day of competition Friday, July 9.

Each Festival day, Saturday, July 3 through Friday, July 9, a closest-to-the-pin winner will be declared (or several, if more than one hole-in-one is made) and asked to return for the final shoot-out slated

for 2 p.m. Saturday, July 10 at Bay Meadows.

The final shoot-out will take place on a 170-yard hole located on the Par Three Golf Course at Bay Meadows. The first person to make a hole-in-one in the final shoot-out will win a Golf Home at Garland Resort.

"It's quite a prize," said John Westerhuis, director of sales at Garland.

He said nobody won the grand prize last year, but one man came close.

The Garland Golf Home will be situated on the fairways lining one of the four 18-hole courses at Garland Resort. It is a Williamsburg, one-and-a-half-story, 2,192-square-foot home complemented by a huge country kitchen and living room. There are three bedrooms, two-and-a-half baths and a large office, which opens into a dining

room.

Guests are greeted by a 48-foot covered front porch, complete with log railings, two dormers, a fireplace, skylight, Pella windows and six-panel solid pine doors. The home features an attached two-car garage, four-inch well and hot water heat.

If none of the finalists succeed, the participant closest to the pin will win a trip for two to a premiere golf destination courtesy of Passageways Travel.

Daily hole-in-one winners will enjoy a Garland Golf Getaway for two people. Each daily prize will feature a two-night stay and 36 holes of golf.




