the 1984 Tournament Players Championship, the 1996 Players Championship and the 1998 Memorial Tournament. His most dominant years were in 1991 and 1992 when his peers voted him Player of the Year.

Mickelson, one of golf's most consistent winners— he has won multiple titles in seven of his 11 years on the PGA Tour — is a short-game master who is also one of golf's longest drivers. He got off to a fast start this year with a victory in the Bob Hope Chrysler Classic. He followed it up by winning the Masters.

Trevino, at the age of 64, is one of golf's legends and ultimate showman. He remains a force, especially on a par-3 course. The winner of 29 PGA Tour events, including six major championships (two U.S. Opens, two British Opens, two PGA Championships) and 29 Champions Tour events, Trevino won the event in 2001 when he made his \$1 million shot.

The Rick Smith Designed "Threetops" Course was named by Travel & Leisure Magazine as the No. 1 par-3 course in the nation in their list of America's Top 5 Par-3 Courses in December of 2002. This award, coupled with Golf Weeks previous ranking of Threetops as their selection of America's best Par-3 Course, offers opportunity for bragging rights to last a lifetime for any player.

This unique Course features holes that range from 135 to 216 yards with a 145-foot vertical drop on hole No. 3. Player's club selections for the Shootout will vary from a pitching wedge to a 5-iron.
