works. Crystal Mountain is planning to open The Park by Water's Edge in July.

Joan O'Neill, Crystal's communication director. said what makes the park unique is that it is not huge like Thunder Falls.

"We didn't feel a largescale water park fit in (Benzie County)," she said.

The one-acre complex will include a 15-person hot tub. a zero-depth entry pool with sides for children and adults, a sand play area and the Mountain Venture Center. Crystal chose to add the water park to enhance its summer offerings.

"In the wintertime, we've been named the top family resort in the Midwest by readers of Ski Magazine," O'Neill said. "What we really felt we needed was something to round out the family atmosphere in the summer.'
