shape of an old tractor, spanning about three acres.

Corn is tallest in September and October, making it an ideal time for mazes — and Halloween scares. The Bolts said people often like to try the maze in the dark. Russ and Cindy, along with their 13- and 10-year-old, enjoy trying to frighten people.

Taylor also likes to cre-

ate a frightening atmosphere in his maze for those who dare enter at night.

"Normally in the two days before Halloween, we do haunted hayrides," he said. "So we're thinking this year, instead of the hayrides, doing a haunted maze and have the maze open at night, and light the maze with kerosene lanterns."

It's \$3 to enter the maze at Wellington Farm Park. The Bolts charge \$5 for adults and \$3.50 for children under 12.
