Christmas Sugar Cookies

- 2 cups margarine
- 3 cups sugar
- 6 eggs
- 1 cup milk
- 6 tsp baking powder
- 1 tsp salt
- 2 tsp vanilla

Cream margarine and sugar, add eggs, and then remaining ingredients. Chill several hours or overnight. Bake for 8-10 minutes at 425 degrees. Do not roll the dough too thin.
