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ANTRIM COUNTY PROPOSALS

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previously approved by the electors and now expired. The Headlee Amendment previously reduced this millage to .9847 mills. This ballot proposal renews the existing .9847 mills and restores the .0153 mills previously rolled back by the Headlee Amendment.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be imposed on taxable property in the Township of Banks, County of Antrim, State of Michigan be increased by up to (1) mill (\$1.00 per thousand dollars of taxable value) on all taxable property in the township for two (2) years, 2004 through 2005 inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for road construction and maintenance? If approved and levied in its entirety, it is estimated that the 1 mill would raise an estimated \$67,054 for the township when first levied in 2004.

CHESTONIA TOWNSHIP

■ Fire Protection Proposal
Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be imposed on taxable property in the Township of Chestonia, County of Antrim, State of Michigan, be increased by up to 2 mills (\$2.00 per thousand dollars of taxable value) on all taxable property in the Township for one (1) year, 2004, for the purpose of providing funds for fire protection? If approved and levied in its entirety, it is estimated that the two (2) mills would raise an estimated \$32,331 for the township

when levied in 2004.

CUSTER TOWNSHIP

■ Garbage Collection Millage Proposal
Being a renewal, shall the constitutional limitation on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by the Township of Custer, County of Antrim, Michigan, against taxable property in the Township be increased by one and one half mill (\$1.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) on all taxable property in the township for four (4) years, 2004 through 2007 inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for the collection of garbage within the township? If approved and levied in its entirety, such increase in millage for such purpose during such period will raise in the first year of such levy an estimated \$128,164.

ECHO TOWNSHIP

■ Fire Protection Millage Proposal
Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be imposed on taxable property in the Township of Echo, County of Antrim, State of Michigan be increased by up to one mill (\$1.00 per thousand dollars [\$1,000] of the taxable value) on all taxable property in the township for four (4) years, 2004 through 2007 inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for fire protection and ambulance services? If approved and levied in its entirety, it is estimated that the 1 mill would raise an estimated \$25,518 for the township

when first levied in 2004.

FOREST HOME TOWNSHIP

■ Road Improvement Proposal
Shall the 15 mill tax limitation on general ad valorem taxes within Forest Home Township imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution be increased for said township by 1 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for the period of 2005 through 2008, inclusive, for the purpose of financing road paving and improvement projects for highways within the Township; and shall the Township levy such increase in millage for such purposes during such period, which increase will raise in the first year of such levy an estimated \$136,104?

MANCELONA TOWNSHIP

■ Proposal #1 Fire Millage Proposal
Shall the 15 mill tax limitation on general ad valorem taxes within Mancelona Township, imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution be increased for said township by .5 mill (\$.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for the period of three (3) years, 2004 through 2006 inclusive, to provide funds for fire department equipment; and shall the Township levy such increase in millage for said purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$38,480?

■ Proposal #2 Road Millage Proposal

Shall the tax limitation on general ad valorem taxes within Mancelona Township, imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution be renewed for said Township by up to 1 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value in the township) for a period of three (3) years, 2005 through 2007 inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for construction, improvement, repair and maintenance of roads within the Township and shall the township levy such increase in millage for said purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$88,321?

WARNER TOWNSHIP

■ Proposal #1 Road Maintenance Proposal
Shall the 15 mill tax limitation on general ad valorem taxes within Warner Township, Antrim County, Michigan, imposed under Article IX, Section 6, of the Michigan Constitution, be renewed for said Township by 1.5 mills (\$1.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of four years; 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007 inclusive, for the improvement, repair, and maintenance of established roads located within the township; and shall the Township levy such increase in millage for such purpose during such period, which increase will raise the first year of such levy an estimated \$19,500?

■ Proposal #2 Elmira-Warner Fire Authority Proposal
Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may

be imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by Warner Township, County of Antrim, State of Michigan, on all taxable property within the territorial limits of the Elmira-Warner Fire Authority, (Elmira Township, Otsego County, Michigan and Warner Township, Antrim County Michigan) be increased by 1 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for four years, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for the operation and maintenance of fire/rescue services? If approved and levied in its entirety, it is estimated that the 1 mill would raise an estimated \$70,141 for the Elmira-Warner Fire Authority in 2004.
