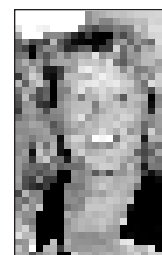

ort and operation of the Manistee County Council on Aging; and shall the County levy such renewal in millage for such purpose during such period, thereby raising in the first year such levy an estimated \$251,631?

TOWNSHIPS

ONEKAMA

Fire/rescue millage renewal
 Shall the previously voted increase in the tax limitation imposed by Section 6, Article IX of the Michigan Constitution of 1963 on general ad valorem taxes within Onekama Township, Manistee County, be renewed at one (1) mill of the taxable value of all property in Onekama Township (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) for a period of five (5) years, 2004 through 2008, inclusive, for the purpose of funding Onekama Township's fire department operating, capital improvement and capital acquisition purposes, including the purchase of fire fighting and emergency response equipment; and shall Onekama Township levy such renewal in millage for said purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$94,398.00. This is a renewal of the previously authorized one (1) mill for fire department operating, capital improvement and fire fighting and emergency response equipment which expired in 2003.

DICKSON

■ **Proposition 1**
 Shall Dickson Township, Manistee County, increase the constitutional limitation on the total amount of general ad valorem taxes imposed on real and tangible property for all purposes in Dickinson Township, Manistee County, by an additional two (2) mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000.00 taxable valuation) and levy an additional two (2) mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of five (5) years (2004 through 2008, inclusive) for the purpose of fire department operating, capital improvement and capital acquisition purposes, including the purchase of fire fighting and emergency response equipment? (This is a renewal of the two (2) mills for fire department operating, capital improvement and fire fighting and emergency response equipment acquisition purposes which expired in 2003; if approved, it is estimated that the revenue generated by this proposal in the first year would be \$59,350.

■ **Proposition 2**
 Shall Dickson Township, Manistee County, increase the constitutional limitation on the total amount of general ad valorem taxes imposed on real and tangible property for all purposes in Dickinson Township, Manistee County, by an additional one and one-half (1.5) mills (\$1.50 per \$1,000 of taxable valuation) and levy an additional one and one-half (1.5) mills (\$1.50 per \$1,000 of taxable valua-

tion) for a period of five (5) years (2004 through 2008, inclusive) for the purpose of providing additional funds for the fire department operations and maintenance expenses? (This is a renewal of the one and one-half (1.5) mills for fire department operation and maintenance expenses which expired in 2003; if approved, it is estimated that the revenue generated by this proposal in the first year would be \$44,514.)

■ **Proposition 1: Ambulance Operations Renewal**
 Shall Norman Township, Manistee County, increase the constitutional limitation on the total amount of general ad valorem taxes imposed on real and tangible property for all purposes in Norman Township, Manistee County, by an additional one (1) mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation) and levy an additional one (1) mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation) for a period of two (2) years (2004-2005 inclusive) for township ambulance operations for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, furnishing and equipping a new township fire and ambulance facility, together with a parking lot and utility improvements and all appurtenances and attachments thereto for use by the township? (This is a renewal request of the one (1) mill for ambulance operations and for constructing and equipping a new township fire and ambulance facility for two(2) years which

expired in 2003; if approved, it is estimated that the revenue generated by this proposal in the first year would be \$40,717.)

Proposition 2: Fire department operations renewal
 Shall Norman Township, Manistee County, increase the constitutional limitation on the total amount of general ad valorem taxes imposed on real and tangible property for all purposes in Norman Township, Manistee County, by an additional two (2) mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000 taxable valuation) and levy an additional two (2) mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000 taxable valuation) for a period of two (2) years (2005-2005 inclusive) for purposes of township fire department operations, and for purposes of acquiring, constructing, furnishing and equipping a new township fire and ambulance facility, together with a parking lot and utility improvements and all appurtenances and attachments thereto for use by the township? (This is a renewal request of the two (2) mills for township fire department operations and for constructing and equipping a new township fire and ambulance facility which expired in 2003; if approved, it is estimated that the revenue generated by this proposal in the first year would be \$81,434.)

MARILLA

Proposition 1: Operating Renewal
 Shall Marilla Township, Manistee County, increase

the constitutional limitation on the total amount of general ad valorem taxes imposed on real and tangible property for all purposes in Marilla Township, Manistee County, by one (1) mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation) and levy an additional one (1) mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation) for a period of five (5) years (2004-2009 inclusive) for general operating purposes of the township? (This is a renewal of one (1) mill for general operating purposes which expires in 2004; if approved, it is estimated that the revenue generated by this proposal in the first year would be \$11,970.)

Proposition 2: Township Hall improvements
 Shall Marilla Township, Manistee County, increase the constitutional limitation on the total amount of general ad valorem taxes imposed on real and tangible property for all purposes in Marilla Township, Manistee County, by one (1) mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation) and levy an additional one (1) mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation) for a period of five (5) years (2004-2008 inclusive) for maintenance, operation and improvements to the Township Hall? (This is a request for an additional one(1) mill for five (5) years for maintenance, operations and improvements to the Township Hall; if approved, it is estimated that the revenue generated by this proposal in the first year would be \$11,621.)
