different recipes prepared by various restaurants from the area and participants get a glass and get to pair up the mac with our wines."

The Leelanau Peninsula Vintners Association was the first official wine trail to form in Michigan, getting started in January 2000. The LPVA organizes four wine trail events annually. In September the group hosts the Harvest Stompede, a run and walk through the vineyards along with gourmet pasta and a special wine pairing at each winery.

Toast the Season in November celebrates the coming holidays. Each participant receives a locally made grapevine wreath, an ornament at each of the 12 wineries, a commemorative logo wine glass, plus a special wine pour at each winery paired with a gournet holiday food item.

In February the group hosts Taste the Passion, which features a snowshoe run or walk through the vineyards and a chocolate and wine tasting experience afterwards. In May the Spring Sip & Savor features new release wines paired with gourmet foods.

good side opens the door to a world of commentary and philosophy. No need to tune into Rush or any of those other radio/TV talking heads, just spend an hour with Bernie and the world will quickly come into perspective.

Back to that customer service thing. If you are reading this article and thinking about getting a van full of friends together and heading out to visit with Bernie at Boskydel you had better do a head count. If you have more than eight in your party the extras better stay back. If you have more than eight in your party Bernie won't serve you and probably will send you packing. His tasting room is small and only holds 8 comfortably and with the exception of the occasional assistance from his sons (one lives in the area and others come back and visit) he mans the tasting room by himself.

At 77, Bernie has become an icon. Not just on the Leelanau Peninsula but across many wine circles. There isn't a winemaker or winery proprietor in the north that hasn't ventured to see Bernie for advice. Advice seekers are not just winemakers — many a customer have received advice on life from Bernie whether they wanted it our not.

At the end of the day it really is all about the wine. There is something special about sitting down and opening a bottle of Boskydel during dinner. It is probably because in every bottle there is a little bit of Bernie, and a little bit of Bernie is good for everyone.
