The Watershed Center Grand Traverse Bay is dedicated to the preservation and protection of Grand Traverse Bay.

The Center works throughout the 1,000 square mile Grand Traverse Bay watershed which encompasses all or part of four counties — Grand Traverse, Leelanau, Antrim and Kalkaska — and the Elk River/Chain of Lakes and the Boardman River. It includes 132 miles of Lake Michigan shoreline.

The bay itself stretches 10 miles across at its widest, is 32 miles long and 600 feet at its deepest point.
